PRESIDENT & EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S MESSAGE

The past 12 months have been filled with overwhelming challenges. Through it all, United Way of Carlisle & Cumberland County mobilized people, strengthened capabilities, and built relationships with community partners. The relentless spirit of this organization, its volunteers, its staff, and its partner agencies is awe-inspiring. The commitment to making life better for others – in good times and particularly in tough times, as we've all experienced this past year – is truly remarkable.

During the COVID-19 crisis, our community's most critical nonprofit organizations serving on the front lines of this emergency (shelters, food pantries, healthcare organizations) felt the physical, emotional, and financial strain while simultaneously altering their services to protect their staff and clients.

During the pandemic, we learned what a crucial role United Way plays within our community and how we could help mobilize and manage aid. United Way of Carlisle & Cumberland County answered the community's call by launching the Carlisle Area Emergency Response (CAER) Fund.

This fund offered a streamlined approach to giving by providing community members, corporations, social service, and faith-based organizations a centralized location to donate to basic needs like access to health care, transportation, financial resources, and food. By collaborating with agencies and programs directly serving clients, United Way ensured support for individuals, families, and community organizations in Boiling Springs, Carlisle, Mt. Holly Springs, New Kingstown, Newville, and Plainfield.

By the end of 2021, United Way of Carlisle & Cumberland County disbursed nearly \$130,000 in emergency assistance and relief, an effort that in a short time had a direct impact on more than 27 organizations providing services to our neighbors. This resulted from collective action, a community coming together to support each other and our struggling families.

While the pandemic relief efforts were extraordinary, these programs are only one facet of our work during this past year. Many in our community continue to experience hardship – particularly ALICE families – many of which were already struggling and whose needs are now even more significant.

In this report, you will learn much about our efforts this past year. Our hard work and agency partners are more vital than ever. As COVID has changed the way we live and work, we remain steadfast in our mission to unite people and resources to build a stronger, healthier Carlisle & Cumberland County.

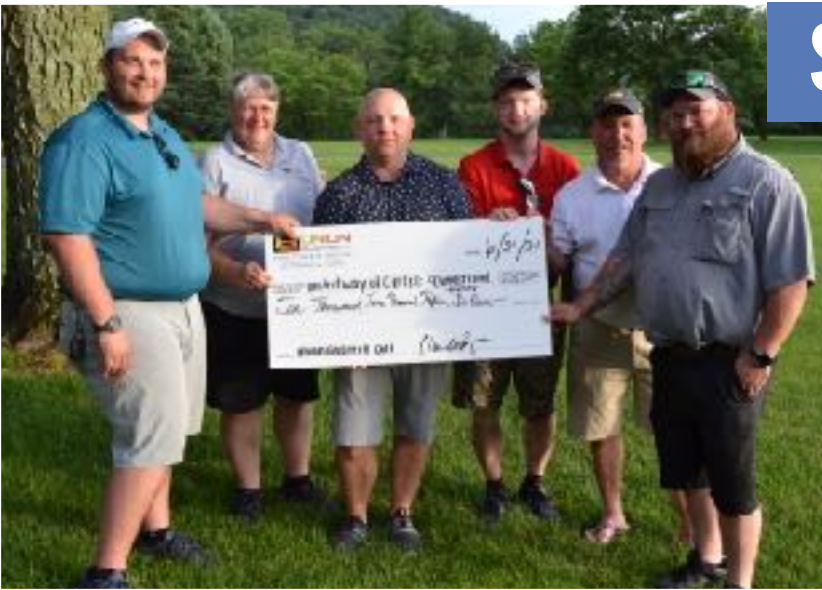

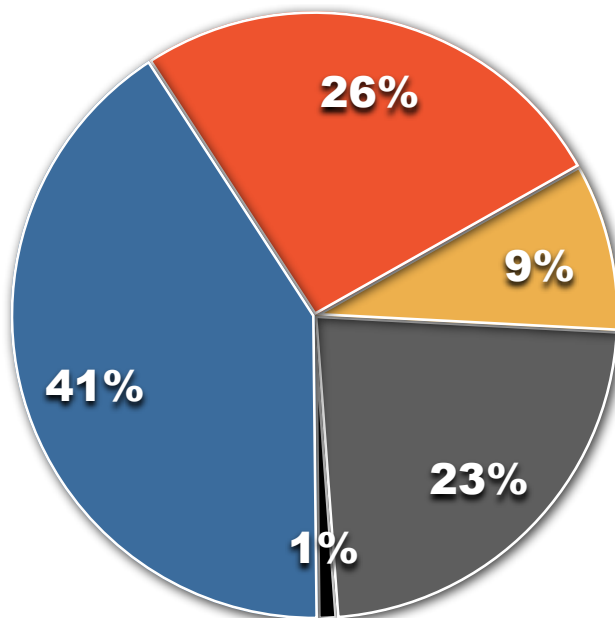

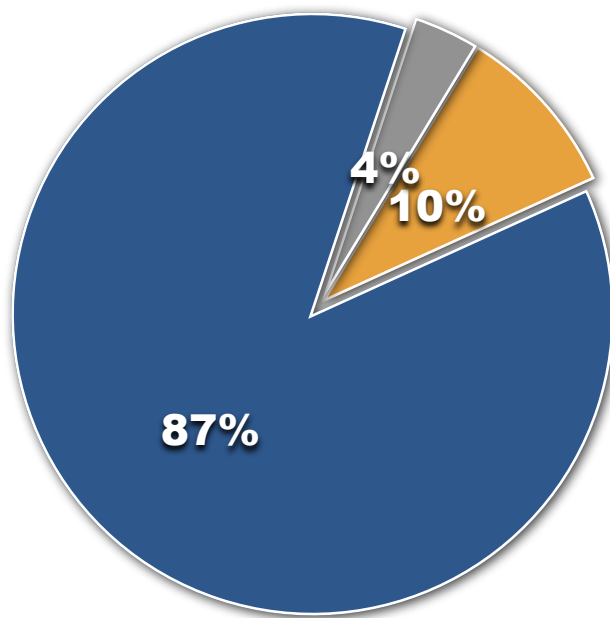
HOW GIVING WAS DIRECTED IN 2021

The Purpose of the Fund:

United Way of Carlisle & Cumberland County partnered with the Carlisle Borough Council to create the Carlisle Area Emergency Response Fund in March 2020 to raise funds to help deal with the emerging needs of the community related to the health pandemic.

The goal of the Carlisle Area Emergency Response Fund Allocation Committee was to support efforts to reduce the spread of COVID-19, to respond to dynamic needs created by the COVID-19 virus, to address emerging health-related needs of the community, to create greater capacity to serve clients who are in need, and to meet community members' basic needs including shelter, food, drink, clothing, proper hygiene, health care, and transportation.

The Committee consisted of various community leaders from Dickinson, Partnership for Better Health, Borough Council and Staff, United Way of Carlisle & Cumberland County, and Carlisle United Methodist Church. Total amount raised: \$129,830.08.
